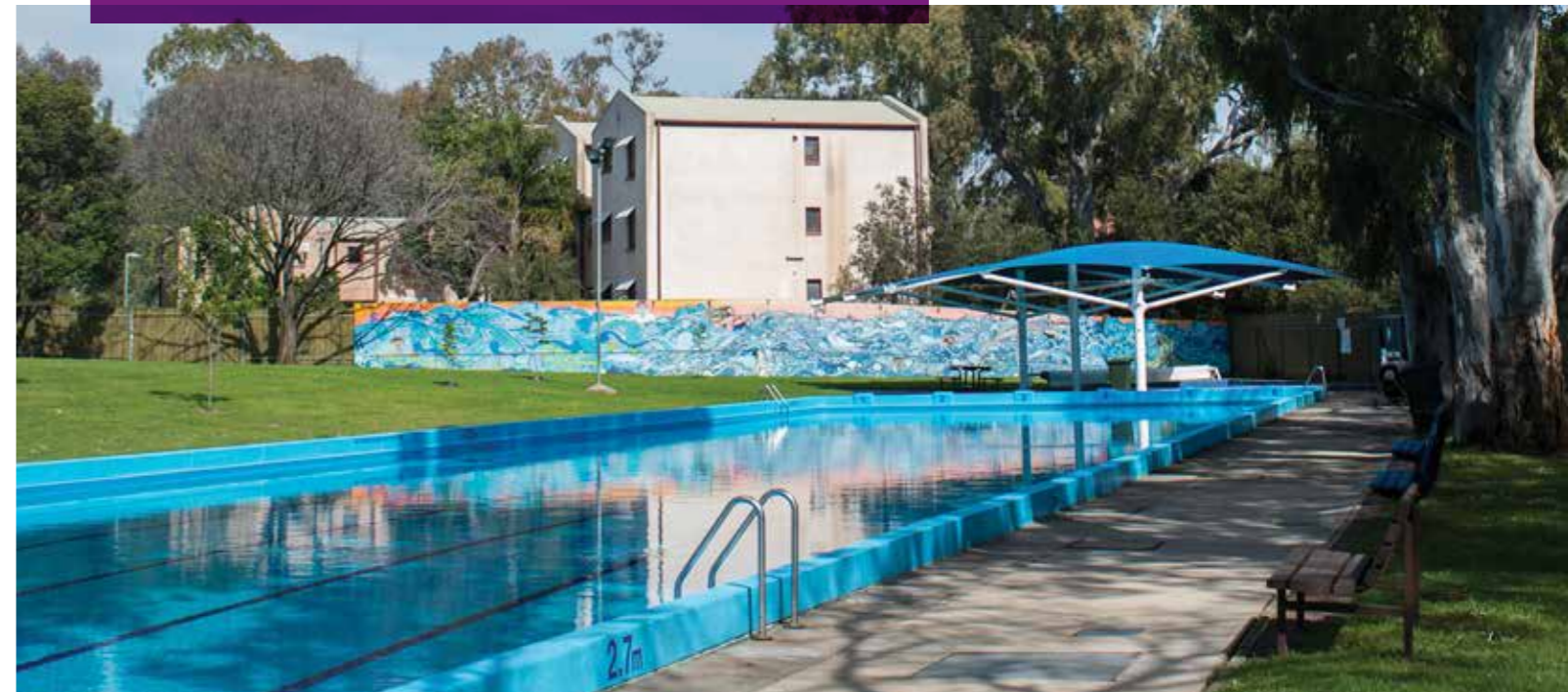

Norwood Swimming Centre

The City of Norwood Payneham & St Peters recognises the importance of providing high quality community facilities to enhance Community Well-being.

In 2016, the Council undertook a review of the Norwood and Payneham Memorial Swimming Centres to ensure that these valued assets continue to remain relevant to the needs and expectations of our community.

The Council resolved that the Long Term Strategy for the Council's Swimming Centres will continue to be based on a two (2) Centre, outdoor pool model. Both the Payneham Memorial Swimming Centre and the Norwood Swimming Centre will be redeveloped to ensure that they will continue to provide adequate facilities for the community over the next 20 years.

In developing design option(s) for the redevelopment of the Swimming Centres, the Council has undertaken an extensive review of the Centres operations, the condition of the existing pool infrastructure, the market in which the Centres operate and competitive challenges.

The Council engaged feedback from the community through various methods, including patron surveys, facilitated Focus Group and information sessions, to inform the development of the preferred options.

The proposed design options for the Norwood Swimming Centre are detailed over the page.

Proposed Design Options

The Council is yet to determine the preferred redevelopment option for the Norwood Swimming Centre. To help guide the decision, feedback is being sought on the proposed options, which provide various amenity improvements and are detailed below.

Option 1.

Complete Centre redevelopment including new swimming pools, leisure water play and replacement of the existing amenities buildings:

- Replacement of the existing six lane 50 metre pool, with an eight lane 25 metre pool;
- Replacement of the learner's pool with a larger pool, which will include a beach entry to enable disabled access;
- Introduce leisure water play via an interactive splash pad for babies and toddlers;
- An inflatable obstacle course, to be used on weekends and school holidays;
- Installation of additional shade, barbeque and picnic facilities;
- Replacement of existing amenities building.

Option 2.

Maintenance of the existing 50 metre swimming pool, replacement of the learner's pool and refurbishment of the existing facilities:

- Required maintenance works to the existing swimming pool, including replacing joint sealant, tiles, plant and equipment;
- Installation of a ramp to enable disabled access to the main pool;
- Replacement of the learner's pool with a larger pool, which will include a beach entry to enable disabled access;
- An inflatable obstacle course, to be used on weekends and school holidays;
- Installation of additional shade, barbeque and picnic facilities;
- Refurbish existing amenities building.

Option 3.

Refurbish the existing 50 metre swimming pool, a new learner's pool and refurbishment of the existing facilities:

- Refurbishment works to the existing 50 metre swimming pool including lining the pool shell with heavy duty steel or fibreglass, reconfiguring the filtration system, a new plant room, replacement of the balance tank and installation of a ramp to enable disabled access;
- Replacement of the learner's pool with a larger pool, which will include a beach entry to enable disabled access;
- An inflatable obstacle course, to be used on weekends and school holidays;
- Installation of additional shade, barbeque and picnic facilities;
- Refurbish existing amenities building.
