Conditions of Entry

- 1. The Canvas Urban Youth Art & Design Exhibition ('Exhibition') is being run by the City of Norwood Payneham & St Peters, 175 The Parade, Norwood SA 5067 (ABN 11390194824) ('the Council').
- 2. The Exhibition will take place at the Norwood Town Hall Customer Service Centre, 175 the Parade Norwood ('Exhibition Venue'), from Monday 1 August 2022 until Wednesday 31 August 2022.
- 3. Expressions of Interest for the Exhibition open at 12 noon, Monday 16 May 2022 ('Opening Date and Time') and close at 12 noon, Thursday 30 June 2022 ('Closing Date and Time'). Late entries will not be accepted.

Entering

- 4. Entry is open to persons aged 10 to 25 years at the Opening Date and Time.
- 5. To enter, an entrant must complete the Canvas Youth Art & Design Exhibition Expression of Interest form and must submit one (1) original artwork to the Council by the Closing Date and Time. Artworks may be submitted in 2D format (eg painting, illustration, photography, graphics, mixed media) or 3D format (eg sculpture, jewellery, textiles).
- 6. Entries are limited to one (1) per person.
- Priority will be given to entrants who live, work, study or volunteer in the City of Norwood Payneham & St Peters.
- 8. Successful and unsuccessful applicants will be notified if their artwork has been selected for display in the Exhibition by Tuesday 19 July 2022.
- 9. All artwork must be supplied ready for hanging or display.
- 10. Selected artwork must be delivered to the Exhibition Venue on Monday 25 July 2022 between 9 am and 5 pm or Tuesday 26 July between 9 am and 12 noon.
- 11. Whilst all reasonable care will be taken in relation to the entrant's artwork by the Council whilst on display at the Exhibition Venue, the Council does not accept any responsibility for any lost or damaged works.
- 12. The Council does not manage the selling of artwork but will be able to provide details of any interested parties to the entrant.

Prize

- 13. The Prize means:
 - Mayors Choice Winner (2D or 3D work) value of \$250;
 - People's Choice Award (2D or 3D work)
 - o 10 − 15 year old Winner (2D or 3D work) \$150;
 - o 16 19 year old Winner (2D or 3D work) \$150; and
 - 20 − 25 year old Winner (2D or 3D work) \$150.

- 18. Winners of each Prize, will be notified by Friday 26 August 2022 and must make contact with the Council's Events Coordinator via email: ydo@npsp.sa.gov.au to arrange for collection. If the Winner does not claim the Prize, the Prize is forfeited without compensation.

General

- 22. Artwork will be available for collection from the Exhibition Venue on Monday 5 September 2022 between 9 pm and 5 pm or Tuesday 6 August September 2022 between 9 am and 12 noon.
- 23. If for any reason the Exhibition is not capable of running as planned, the Council reserves the right to cancel, terminate, suspend or modify the Exhibition.
- 24. The entrant agrees that they provide unconditional consent to the Council to use their name, image and photographs, including photographs of their artwork submitted to the Exhibition, for publicity and promotional purposes in connection with the Exhibition without compensation, and agrees that the Council will own the copyright of any such images and photographs and in all material incorporating the photographs for an unlimited period of time without further notification, remuneration or compensation for the purpose of promoting, publicising or marketing the Exhibition.
