

CONDITIONS OF PERMIT

A Permit Holder Shall:

- Only conduct the Activity during the hours and the period agreed upon with the Council
- Comply with all directions of the Council Officers and/or members of the SA Police
- Upon request of any Council or Police Officer, produce a valid copy of the permit with its conditions
- Provide enough footpath space for pedestrians to pass unhindered, including wheelchairs and prams

In connection with the Activity a Permit Holder shall not without the Council's permission:

- Create, in the opinion of any Officer of the Council or the Police, a nuisance that may adversely affect the public and/or local businesses
- Sell, offer or display for sale any articles or commodities, unless written permission has first been obtained from the Council
- Transfer the permit to any other person
- Conduct the Activity so that it disturbs a performance or event held or approved by the Council

Children:

- A permit may be issued to a parent or a guardian of a child under 18 years of age, if supervision by the parent or guardian will be undertaken for the duration of the performance
