1. Assessment Number

Your Assessment Number is a unique number allocated to your property address and rates account.

2. Valuation Number

Your Valuation Number is a Land Services Group (State Government) issued Number that identifies your property address.

3. Full Year Balance

Total amount outstanding including arrears. .

4. Quarterly Amount

The Quarter Rates Balance including arrears, for the quarterly Rating Period.

5. Due Date

The payment due date for the quarterly amount or for the full year balance.

6. Arrears

Outstanding rates or charges from previous billing periods that have not yet been paid.

7. eNotices

Sign Up to receive rate notices by email. Enter your email address and the eNotice reference number shown on the current rate notice. It's quick easy and secure!

8. Payble

Payble allows you to pay your rates in instalments.
