

A Portrait of our City – Community Calendar Competition

Conditions of Entry

1. The Competition is being run by the City of Norwood Payneham & St Peters (the Council), 175 the Parade, Norwood SA 5067 (ABN 11390194824).
2. Entries for the Competition open at 12:00pm, Tuesday 11 August 2026 and close at 5:00pm, Friday 25 September 2026. Late entries will not be accepted.
3. The Competition is open to the following people of any age:
 - a. all residents who live in the Council area;
 - b. all workers who work within the Council area; and
 - c. all students who attend school in the Council area.
4. For Entrants under the age of eighteen (18) parental or guardian consent is required. The consenting parent or guardian is then bound by these Terms and Conditions and will be required to sign the online form at the time of entering the Competition.
5. The image or drawing submitted must depict a place, location or subject within the Council area that reflects, 'places you love in our City'.
6. The Competition is open to all photographic and drawing abilities, from professional to novice.
7. Entries are limited to one (1) per person.
8. Only valid entries will be considered. To be a valid entry the entrant must submit the completed Entry Form to the Council by the Closing Date and Time either:
 - a. In person at the Council Customer Service Centre (175 The Parade, Norwood) using the paper Entry Form with an original drawing or painting attached; or
 - b. online via with an original photograph (digital high-resolution) or digital drawing attached.
9. The Entrant is responsible for obtaining consent from any relevant persons whose image has been used in any photograph(s) submitted to the Council as part of the Competition. An entry into the Competition will be accepted by the Council on the basis that consent has been obtained by the participant from the relevant persons.
10. Twelve winning entries will be selected and featured, with one winning entry showcased each month in the 2027 Council Community Calendar. The winner's first name will be printed alongside their entry. The calendars will be available for use and distribution to residents and community members at Council facilities.

11. The Winners will be selected in the week beginning Monday 5 October 2026 at the Council offices, 175 The Parade, Norwood by a judging panel comprising of the Council's Coordinator, Events & Campaign, Governance Officer and Graphic Designer.
12. Each winner will be notified via email by Tuesday 13 October 2026.
13. If for any reason the Competition is not able to be conducted as planned, the Council reserves the right to cancel, terminate, suspend or modify the Competition.
14. The Entrant (or their parent/guardian) agrees to provide unconditional consent to the Council to use their entry for publicity and promotional purposes in connection with the Competition without compensation and agrees that the Council will own the copyright of any such material for an unlimited period of time without further notification, remuneration or compensation for the purpose of promoting, publicising or marketing the Competition.
15. The Council may use the photographs submitted as part of the Competition beyond the conclusion of the Competition, for marketing, promotional and research purposes, unless the Entrant expressly states otherwise.
16. Due regard will be given to the preservation of the artistic integrity of the photographs. The Council will not edit, alter or demean any photographs. The Council does retain the right to crop the images for reproduction and promotional purposes.
17. To the extent permitted by law, the Council is not liable and excluded from all liability for any loss, damage, injury or death (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss) suffered or sustained by any person whether caused directly or indirectly by any act or omission of the Council or its servants or agent in connection with the Competition.
