Eastern Adelaide SA Climate Change Adaptation Plan and Sector Agreement Finalised

The Cities of Adelaide, Burnside, Norwood Payneham and St Peters, Unley, Tea Tree Gully, and Prospect, along with the City Council of Campbelltown and the Town of Walkerville, have signed a Climate Change Sector Agreement with the State Government.

Chair of the Eastern Region Alliance, Mr Paul Di Iulio said "The Resilient East Climate Change Adaptation Plan is a testament to the collaborative nature of the eight councils of the Eastern Adelaide region."

The Sector Agreement helps to underpin the partnership between the State Government and the councils on their continued collaboration in delivering upon the actions identified in the Resilient East Regional Climate Change Adaptation Plan.

The Hon Ian Hunter MLC, Minister for Climate Change, said "The signing of the Sector Agreement is a great opportunity for us to recognise that climate change does indeed affect us all, sometimes in different ways, and to understand that adaptation is a key part in keeping our environment, communities, and businesses resilient."
